



SPEEDWAY & CAMPING RULES

The following rules are in place. Please review the following information. Failure to observe rules will result in eviction and possible prosecution. No unlawful activities, Federal, State, and local laws must be obeyed.

- Quiet Hours are in effect from 1:00 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. daily.
- Respect those camping around you. Keep music at a lower volume during the late evening hours.
- Keep pets leashed at all times. No pets allowed inside track. Owners are responsible for removing waste.
- Winchester Speedway reserves the right to deny access to any vehicle at any time.
- All Golf Cart/ATV Rules will **strictly be enforced**;
 - No drivers under the age of 14 will be allowed
 - Driving Under The Influence (DUI) **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** and you will be arrested!
 - No driving over 10 MPH.
 - All vehicles operating on Timber Lane Road (road running towards main gate) must be street legal.
 - BASICALLY meaning don't ride ATV's or Golf Carts on Timber Lane.
 - No driving golf carts or ATV's after 1 am
 - No racing of any vehicles in the campground or spectator areas.
 - Any rule not being observed, your Cart/ATV will be impounded for the remainder of the weekend and you will be asked to leave the property for the remainder of the weekend.
- All parking must be **WITHIN** your allotted campsite, anything outside of your campsite will be towed and you will be responsible for the expense.
- Offensive signs, public intoxication and profanity will not be tolerated.
- No fireworks, firearms or weapons are permitted on facility grounds. Any other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by Event and/or Series Security Personnel is at their sole discretion and will be confiscated.
- Winchester Speedway assumes no responsibility for loss, theft or damage of individual's private property.
- All trash to be removed and placed in a dumpster/trash can before weekend is over.
- No Reselling of camping spots, once they are purchased you are responsible.
- **ABSOLUTELY** no parking, of any kind, between the Utility Poles and State Road 32 or you will be ticketed and towed by the Indiana State Police, there are NO EXCEPTIONS to this.
- Direct any NON-Emergency calls to the on grounds race track staff or security.
- For emergency services - fire, police, ambulance call 911.

Winchester Speedway, its representatives and contracted agents reserve the right to amend campsite rules at any time. Failure to comply with the stated and posted rules may result in expulsion from the facility and or legal action by Law Enforcement. Winchester Speedway reserves the right to refuse camp ground entrance to any individual(s) and or camper(s).
